

SPACE SAVER SPARE WHEELS

We ask what type of spare wheel your vehicle has because it affects the size and shape of the Bootliner

Traditionally most vehicles USED to be supplied with a Steel or Aluminium Spare wheel that was the same size and style as those fitted to the vehicle for road use.


In the last few years there has been a move to supply vehicles with a smaller emergency spare wheel that is commonly known as a Spacesaver

It will normally have a yellow or red notice on it warning about a maximum speed when fitted (50 MPH / 80 Km/H)
